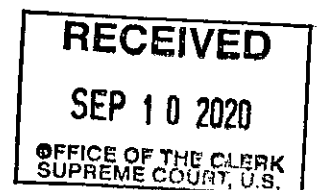

II.




