Request for extension of time

Dear Mr. Harris:

I write on behalf of respondents to request a second extension of time to oppose the petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter. The current deadline is March 16, 2022. Respondents respectfully seek an extension of thirty days, which would make the opposition due April 15, 2022. Petitioners' counsel advises that petitioners oppose this request.

The extension is warranted due to the continuing press of other work that requires attention in the same timeframe, including work in this Court, most immediately, preparing an opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari in *Green Haven Preparative Meeting v. New York State Department of Corrections and Community Supervision*, No. 21-1027, an opposition to the petition for a writ certiorari in *Dr. A. v. Hochul*, No. 21-1143, and a reply in support of the petition for a writ of certiorari in *New York v. Yellen*, No. 21-966. Other important commitments of the attorneys most knowledgeable about this case also make it difficult to prepare a response to the petition in the time currently allotted.
