I, Miguel E. Larios, am counsel of record for the respondents in the above-captioned case and am writing to request a 30-day extension of time in which to file a response to the petition for writ of certiorari. The petition was placed on the court's docket on July 22, 2021, and a response to the petition is currently due August 26, 2021. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request a 30-day extension of time, to and including September 23, 2021, in which to file a response to the petition. The additional time is warranted because of the numerous obligations myself and my co-counsel have had over the past 30 days in both state and Federal Court, including additional class certification briefing in the matter of *Simpson, et al v.
