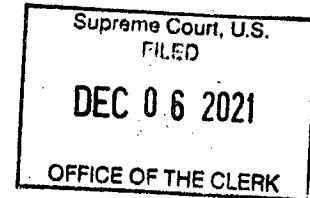

Pursuant to the U.S. Supreme Court Rule 13. Review on Certiorari: Time for Petitioning I respectfully request this Honorable Court to Grant me an additional 60 days to file my *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* based on extraordinary circumstances.
