Dear Mr. Harris:

On February 14, 2022, the government filed its petition for writ of certiorari, in which the government requested that the Court hold the petition pending the Court's decision in *Alfred H. Siegel, Trustee of the Circuit City Stores, Inc. Liquidating Trust v. John P. Fitzgerald, III, Acting United States Trustee for Region 4*, S.Ct. No. 21-441 (the "Siegel Case"), and then dispose of the petition as appropriate in light of that decision. On April 4, 2022, the Court requested that the Respondents file a response to the government's petition on or before May 4, 2022. Respondents' response is now due, after two extensions, on July 1, 2022.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the rules of this Court, I respectfully request a further extension of time to and including August 1, 2022, within which to file the Respondents' response. This extension is necessary because the attorney with principal responsibility for preparation of the Respondents' response has been engaged with the press of other already-pending matters and because the Respondent needs additional time to prepare its response in light of the Court's June 6, 2022, decision in the Siegel Case and the Court's June 13, 2022, summary disposition in *Office of the United States Trustee v. John Q. Hammons*, S.Ct. No. 21-1078.

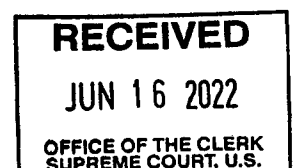
The government consents to this further extension.
