On February 14, 2022, the government filed its petition for writ of certiorari, in which the government requested that the Court hold the petition pending the Court's decision in *Alfred H. Siegel, Trustee of the Circuit City Stores, Inc. Liquidating Trust v. John P. Fitzgerald, III, Acting United States Trustee for Region 4*, S.Ct. No. 21-441 (the "Siegel Case"), and then dispose of the petition as appropriate in light of that decision. On April 4, 2022, the Court requested that the Respondents file a response to the government's petition on or before May 4, 2022. Respondents' response is now due, after three extensions, on August 1, 2022.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the rules of this Court, I respectfully request a further extension of time to and including September 1, 2022, within which to file the Respondents' response. This extension is necessary because Respondents has not yet been able to retain counsel that is a member of the Bar of the Court. The undersigned will be seeking admission to the Bar of the Court expeditiously, but needs additional time to do that. The government consents to this further extension.

In the alternative, Respondents request that they be excused from filing a response in light of this Court's June 6, 2022, decision in the Siegel Case, as well as this Court's June 13, 2022, summary disposition in *Office of the United States Trustee v. John Q. Hammons*, S.Ct. No. 21-1078, and June 27, 2022, summary disposition in *Bast Amron LLP v. United States Trustee Regio*, 21, S.Ct. No. 21-1354. The government has no position on this request.

Pursuant to Rule 29.6 of the rules of this Court, I respectfully state that there are no parent or publicly held companies owning 10% or more of any of the Respondents. Furthermore, I note that I am not currently a member of the Bar of the Court and acknowledge that the Respondents' response to the government's petition must be filed by a Bar member.
