I am counsel for respondents in the above-referenced case. On April 19, 2022, the Court called for a response to the petition for certiorari, which was docketed on April 5, 2022. Absent an extension, the brief in opposition would be due on May 19, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, I respectfully request an extension of 32 days, to and including Monday, June 20, 2022.
