
Dear Clerk of Court:

I am writing on behalf of Wilmington Savings Fund Society, FSB, as Trustee of Stanwich Mortgage Trust F (“Wilmington”), in relation to a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari (the “Petition”) that was filed on or about July 29, 2021 in the Supreme Court of the United States Case No. 21-134. Wilmington wishes to file an opposition to the Petition. However, we need additional time to prepare the opposition for filing. The current deadline is Monday, August 30, 2021. We are seeking a thirty day extension, which a proposed new filing date of September 29, 2021.

The Holland & Knight offices remain closed due to the pandemic, save for mandatory in-office appearances. Accordingly, the efficiency in briefing substantial documents is noticeably decreased due to the lack of resources available from within our offices. Counsel for Wilmington is unable to meet the filing deadline of August 30, 2021.

Of note, I am not currently admitted to practice before the Supreme Court of the United States. 
The proposed extension, through and including September 13, 2021, will not prejudice any party and is made in compliance with Rule 30.4.
