1. I am an attorney and a member of the Bar of this Court.
2. I submit this Declaration to explain briefly why I am resending paper copies (enclosed, original signatures re-executed today) of my Application for Extension of Time Within Which To File a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit (the “Application”) and the accompanying Proof of Service thereof (the “Proof”).
