

In the second round through the District and Fifth Circuit Court I submitted fresh information that, the Dallas Appeal Court, through multiple Rulings and a denial of the Defendant's Petition of the Texas Supreme Court in 2020, confirmed that the proposed Peyton Jr. Orders were in fact incomplete/nonlegal orders as they were not signed by the Court.

In May 2020 the Dallas Probate Court #3 attempted to rectify this issue with a sophomoric attempt to validate the then 7 year old orders. Upon review, the Dallas Appeal Court stated it was, "too little too late" and the Dallas Probate Court #3 effort did not legitimize the proposed Peyton Jr. Orders.

After the 2020 Rulings by the Dallas Appeal Court, I asked the Defendant to remove Abstract he placed on me in the Fall of 2013. He refused and I then repeated my request many times including the latest in May of this year.

Instead of removing the Abstract, based on now voided Peyton Jr. proposed Orders, the defendant filed a Motion with the Dallas Probate Court #3 on June 9, 2022 requesting that the Probate Court sign the Proposed Peyton Jr. Orders to make them Final State Orders [copy of a portion of the first page is attached] (App. 1). The Court originally set the Hearing for this Motion for September 19, 2022 but recently postponed it to an undetermined date. By the very presentation of this Motion, the Defendant admits that the Proposed Peyton Jr. Orders are not valid without the Court signature. Yet again for a third time, I prove without

Any representation that it existed or it exists and can invoke the *Rooker Feldman* Doctrine is deceitful and completely without merit.

I again pray that this Court accept this Petition and place this on the Supreme Court docket to hear my case for the denial of my civil rights to have a fair trial in the Texas Court system in accordance with Texas Law.
