Having sufficiently considered the information and motion for final order of discipline and the response to the show cause order, the Court finds that Respondent, Mark T. 

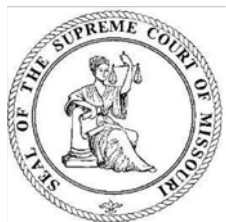
