I represent Google LLC in the above-referenced case. Google, like petitioner Twitter, Inc., was a defendant-appellee in the Ninth Circuit proceedings below, No. 18-17192.

Pursuant to this Court's Rule 12.6, I write to notify the Court that Google maintains its interest in the outcome of the petition, which is conditioned on a grant of certiorari in *Gonzalez v. Google LLC*, No. 21-1333. Google intends to oppose the *Gonzalez* petition on or before the opposition's due date of July 5, 2022. All of the parties in *Taamneh* have stipulated that should this Court deny the petition in *Gonzalez*, the plaintiffs in *Taamneh* will dismiss the *Taamneh* case. *Taamneh* Pet. 2 (citing N.D. Cal.
