The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on June 3, 2022. This Court called for a response. After two extensions, that response is now due on October 28, 2022. We respectfully request, under this Court's Rule 30.4, a further and final extension of time to and including November 4, 2022, within which to file a brief in opposition.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the response have been heavily engaged with the press of other matters with proximate due dates. In addition, the response is being prepared with the assistance of students in Stanford Law School's Supreme Court Litigation Clinic, and the extension of time is necessary to ensure that students are meaningfully involved in the brief's preparation.
