I am counsel of record for Respondent Kite Pharma, Inc. in the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, I am writing to request a 40-day extension of time to file Respondent's brief in opposition to certiorari.

The petition for certiorari was docketed on June 15, 2022, after Petitioner received a 60-day extension. The deadline for Respondent to oppose the petition is July 15, 2022.
