Dear Mr. Harris:

I represent Respondent in the above-captioned case. The Court docketed the petition for a writ of certiorari on June 17, 2022. On August 9, 2022, the Court called for a response. On August 25, 2022, the Court granted Respondent's motion to extend the time to file her brief in opposition. The brief in opposition is currently due October 11, 2022.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests an additional 30-day extension, up to and including November 10, 2022, to file her brief in opposition. Petitioner consents to this request.

The extension of time is necessary given the press of other matters that members of my team and I have needed to and still must attend to, including:

- a brief in opposition in *Department of Interior v. Navajo Nation*, No. 22-51 (U.S.), filed September 23, 2022;
- a brief in opposition in *Arizona v. Navajo Nation*, No. 21-1484 (U.S.), filed September 23, 2022;

- a reply brief in *Saba Capital CEF Opportunities 1, Ltd. v. Nuveen Floating Rate Income Fund*, No. 22-407 (2d Cir.), filed September 30, 2022;
- oral argument in *Rodney Reed v. Bryan Goertz*, No. 21-442 (U.S.), on October 11, 2022; and
- and a petition for a writ of certiorari to review the judgment of the Eighth Circuit in *Pulsifer v. United States*, 39 F.4th 1018 (8th Cir.), due October 11, 2022.

Given these deadlines, Respondent respectfully requests a 30-day extension of time to file her brief in opposition, up to and including November 10, 2022.

I have communicated with counsel for Petitioner. Petitioner consents to this request.
