Dear Mr. Bickell:

Please accept this letter as Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to respond to Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. We request this extension based on the following:

1. Petitioner has represented that his Brother, Nahed Abdulnabi, intends to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this matter.
2. The Tennessee Supreme Court rejected Brother's Application for Permission to Appeal on August 4, 2021.
3. If he files, it should be relatively soon.
4. Judicial economy would be served by considering the two (2) Petitions at the same time.
5. In addition, because they both arise from the same trial court judgment, the risk of inconsistent results is minimized if the matters are considered together.
