Please accept this letter as Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to respond to Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. We request this extension based on the following:

1. Petitioner has represented that his Brother, Nahed Abdulnabi, intends to file a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this matter.
2. Respondent's attorney received a Petition for Writ of Certiorari from Brother dated November 3, 2021, but this Court has not yet received or docketed same.
3. Judicial economy would be served by considering the two (2) Petitions at the same time.
