Dear Mr. Bickell:

Please accept this letter as Respondent's Motion for Extension of Time to respond to Petitioner's and his Brother's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. We request this extension based on the following:

1. Petitioner's Brother, Nahed Abdelnabi, served a Petition for Writ of Certiorari ("Petition") in this matter on November 3, 2021, the last day allowed. It has not yet been docketed and was apparently returned to him for corrections.
2. Petitioner understands that the Brother has sixty (60) days from the date the Petition was received by the Clerk's Office (November 9, 2021) to refile the Petition with corrections.
3. Judicial economy would be served by considering the two (2) Petitions for Writ of Certiorari that arise from the same order at the same time, especially since the Brothers were found to be co-conspirators, working together (along with Brother's wife) to deprive Respondent and her children of their rights (a finding upheld on review and unchallenged herein).
4. Although Respondent is loath to request yet another extension to file her Response in Opposition to the Petitions, she cannot respond until she learns exactly what is in the Brother's Petition that is yet to be filed.

5. No disadvantage will come to the Brothers as they have used the delays along the course of this case (over ten (10) years now) to flagrantly violate the rendering court's orders and dispose of and/or withhold monies and properties lawfully awarded to Respondent. The onus of the delay is on Respondent and the parties' children.

Based on the foregoing, Respondent respectfully requests an extension to thirty (30) days from her receipt of the notice of docketing of the Brother's Petition to file her Response in Opposition.
