
This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated August 17, 2021, to Michael Murphy, advising that his "petition for writ of certiorari" was filed on August 13, 2021 and placed on the docket August 17, 2021 as No. 21-228. Included with the letter were forms for "Proof of Service" and a "Notice" to me that any "brief in opposition" was due on Thursday, September 16, 2021. The letter also contained a form for a "Waiver" of any response to the writ.

I am not currently a member of the Supreme Court Bar, but by separate correspondence, I am, today, simultaneously submitting my Application for Admission to Practice before the Supreme Court of the United States with all supporting, required documentation, "Statement of Sponsors," and "Motion for Admission," along with the required filing fee.

I consulted the Court's website for instructions on a response, and I also reached out to the helpline for the electronic filing registration. During that conversation, I was advised that since I was not a member of the Supreme Court Bar, I could not utilize the e-filing system. I was also advised that the next "Order List" will not be published until October 4, 2021, which would be after the deadline for filing the response on behalf of my clients.

Lastly, I was also told that I could submit this letter requesting an extension of the deadline in which to file the response to the writ petition until after my application for admission is received, reviewed, and hopefully approved, making me a Member of the Supreme Court Bar.

As such, please accept this as my formal request that my clients be given a sixty (60) day extension in which to file their response to Mr. Murphy's "petition for writ of certiorari" in this matter. This should allow for sufficient time for my application for bar admission to be received, reviewed, and hopefully approved.




