I represent Respondent in the case referenced above. Petitioner Oklahoma filed petition for a writ of certiorari on August 21, 2021, and this matter was placed on the docket on August 24, 2021. Respondent requested and received a 30-day extension of his deadline to file a response from September 23, 2021 to October 25, 2021. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, I write to request a fourteen (14) day extension of time to file a response to the petition in this case.

Respondent's counsel has received notice that multiple *amici* intend to file briefs in support of the petition in *Oklahoma v. Castro-Huerta*, No. 21-429, which raises the same questions presented as this case and which Oklahoma has urged the Court to grant as a vehicle to address those questions presented. Counsel requires time to review those briefs before filing a response in this case.
