Dear Mr. Harris:

Under Supreme Court Rule 30.4, Respondent Bobby Lumpkin, Director, Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Correctional Institutions Division, respectfully moves for an extension of the time for filing his response to the petition for a writ of certiorari in this matter.

This is a capital case. The response is currently due on September 23, 2021. Respondent requests a 30-day extension, creating a new filing date of October 25, 2021.* My office conferred with counsel for Petitioner on September 13, and Petitioner does not oppose the requested extension.

The extension is needed because the undersigned counsel and other counsel assisting with this matter have numerous briefing obligations, including:
