STATEMENT OF THE CASE

1. In October of 2019, while Working as a School Psychologist in Stafford County, Virginia, I Filed a Case in the Northern District Court of West Virginia, Martinsburg Division
2. In January of 2020, An Order was Issued by Chief Justice Mrs. Gina Groh, the Order was Public. In part, the Order;
 - 2.A. Filing of Abuse of Discretionary Power (Against Maggie Kuhl, GAL)
 - 2.B. Removed Maggie Kuhl as guardian-ad-litem
 - 2.C. Removed Any and ALL Orders in Relation to Maggie Kuhl
 - 2.D. Removed Family Court Judge, Sean Maynard from Wayne County, West Virginia
 - 2.E. Re-assigned the Case to Berkeley County, West Virginia
 - 2.F. Re-Funded ALL Fees Paid to Maggie Kuhl, totaling \$40,000.
- 3.0. Around February of 2020, FISC became Involved in my Case, Removed the Order from Public View and ALL Copies of the Order were either Removed or Destroyed,
4. Then, On February 10, 2020, After FISC Had the Order Removed, Maggie Kuhl Re-joined the Case as GAL.

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

- 1) To Protect a Disabled, Minor Child from Being Abused.
- 2) To Discourage the Attorney General of West Virginia,
Patrick ^(Morrisey) Morrisey, from Interfering in Future Child Abuse, Child Custody Cases.

(In 2014, Patrick Morrisey, the Attorney General of West Virginia, Interjected Himself into the Case.

I Filed a Complaint with the West Virginia Board of Accounting (WVBOA) against Franklin Austin, CPA, who After Numerous Requests, Still Refused to Provide Me, his Client, with a Copy of My Own Tax Returns, which Franklin Austin, CPA, from Austin & Associates A.C. had Prepared Himself.

Based Upon Correspondence (FAX) from the Attorney General of West Virginia, Patrick Morrisey to the WVBOA, My Complaint was Dismissed.

- 3) To Remind FISC that they Should NOT be Involved in a Child Negligence, Child Custody Case.

ISCI's Jurisdictional Errors.


