Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am counsel for respondents in the above-referenced case. On September 21, 2021, the Court docketed a certiorari petition in this case, and on November 10, 2021, the Court requested that respondents file a response to the petition. Unless extended by the Court, the response would be due on December 10.

Pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 30 days, to and including January 10, 2022. I have several pressing obligations during the upcoming weeks, including multiple major briefing deadlines and hearings.
