United States Constitution - Fourteenth Amendment

Section 3

No Person shall be a Senator or Representative in Congress, or elector of President and Vice-President, or hold any office, civil or military, under the United States, or under any State, who, having previously taken an oath, as a member of Congress, or as an officer of the United States, or as a member of any State legislature, or as an executive or *judicial officer of any State*, to support the Constitution of the United States, shall have engaged in **insurrection or rebellion** against the same, **or given aid or comfort to the enemies thereof**.

But Congress may by a vote of two-thirds of each House, remove such disability.

Universal Citation: CA Constitution art I § 7. SEC. 7. (a) A person may not be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law or denied equal protection of the laws; provided, that nothing contained herein or elsewhere in this Constitution imposes upon the State of California or any public entity, board, or official any obligations or responsibilities which exceed those imposed by the Equal Protection Clause of the 14th Amendment to the United States
