
Dear Mr. Bickell:

Petitioner Uber Technologies, Inc. writes in reply to Respondent Damaris Rosales's January 10, 2022 letter asking the Court to hold Petitioner's Petition for a Writ of Certiorari pending the Court's disposition of *Viking River Cruises, Inc. v.
