
**APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED  
*IN FORMA PAUPERIS***

Petitioner Roosevelt Rico Dahda moves under Supreme Court Rule 39 for leave to file the accompanying Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Mr. Dahda sought and was granted permission to proceed *in forma pauperis* in the federal district court and the Tenth Circuit, the latter of which appointed undersigned counsel pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act of 1964, 18 U.S.C. §3006A. The Tenth Circuit's appointment order was issued on January 28, 2020, effective *nunc pro tunc* to the date of Mr. Dahda filed his notice of appeal in the Tenth Circuit (*to wit*, December 21, 2019).
