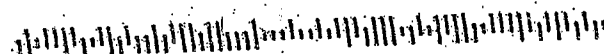

William Barrett Slade, II, has filed a motion for reconsideration, pursuant to 11th Cir. R. 22-1(c) and 27-2, of this Court's order dated April 6, 2020, denying his motions for a certificate of appealability and for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, in his appeal from the district court's denial of his *pro se* 28 U.S.C. § 2254 habeas corpus petition, motion for summary judgment, evidentiary hearing, and appointment of counsel, and Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e) motion to alter or amend final judgment.
