I am counsel of record for the respondents in the above-captioned case. The response to the petition for certiorari is currently due January 7, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondents respectfully request that the time for filing a response be extended by 14 days, to and including January 21, 2022. This is respondents' second request for an extension. Previously, the time in which to respond was extended by 36 days, from December 2, 2021, to January 7, 2022. Good cause exists for the requested extension. I am scheduled to undergo an outpatient surgical procedure on January 6, 2022—the day before the response's current due date. In addition, I have had to miss several other days of work in December for other medical procedures for family members. The delays caused by those commitments have made it difficult to complete a draft in time for necessary reviews by others within the California Department of Justice during the winter holidays. Finally, we have learned that a petition for certiorari is likely to be filed on January 14 in another case, see ERISA Indus. Committee v.
