Second Motion to Extend Time to File Response to Petition for Writ of Certiorari

Dear Mr. Harris:

Please substitute me as counsel of record for Respondents in the above-referenced matter. I write to request an extension of an additional 7 days to file an opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in the above-referenced case pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30(4). The petition was docketed on July 15, 2021, which would ordinarily have required a response on August 16, 2021. A first request for an extension, until September 30, 2021, was granted on August 9, 2021. We now request until October 7, 2021 to respond.

Counsel of record for the Petitioner consented to this extension until October 7, 2021 by email.

Good cause exists for the requested second extension. Since the first request was made, seven amici have filed briefs in support of the petition. Additionally, Covid-19 has continued to complicate matters in our office, with an individual witness who spent the day in the office preparing for trial testing positive for Covid-19, thereby disrupting the work schedules of the team members working in the office because of the need to follow the appropriate protocols.

Respondents respectfully request that they be granted an additional 7 days, up to and including October 7, 2021, in which to file their brief in opposition to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
