## MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, Dexter Earl Kemp, pursuant to SUP CT. R. 39.1, respectfully moves for leave to file the accompanying petition for writ of certiorari in the Supreme Court of the United States without payment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
