






The Supreme Court of South Carolina

ORDER

Petitioner has filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus, a notice for motion to order and petition for declaratory judgment and injunction relief, and a notice and motion for consent to supplement the record extraordinary writ pursuant to Rule 212(b) in this Court's original jurisdiction. Petitioner has failed to show any constitutional violations that constitute a denial of fundamental fairness shocking to the universal sense of justice. *Butler v. State*, 302 S.C. 466, 468, 397 S.E.2d 87, 88 (1990). Therefore, the petition for a writ of habeas corpus is denied. Further, we decline to entertain Petitioner's remaining requests for relief in our original jurisdiction. *See Key v. Currie*, 305 S.C. 115, 116, 406 S.E.2d 356, 357 (1991) (holding this Court will not entertain matters in its original jurisdiction where the matter can be entertained in the lower courts unless there is a question of public importance or an emergency).
