**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE;
VACATING ORDER DENYING
LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA*
PAUPERIS; GRANTING *PAUPER*
STATUS; DENYING MOTION FOR
APPOINTMENT OF COUNSEL**

(Docket Nos. 7, 13)

Petitioner, a California prisoner, filed a pro se petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254, challenging his state conviction out of San Mateo County. Petitioner has filed a motion for reconsideration of the Court's denial of his motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis, (Docket Nos. 18, 19), and a motion for appointment of counsel, (Docket No. 13).

I. DISCUSSION

A. Standard of Review

This court may entertain a petition for a writ of habeas corpus "in behalf of a person in custody pursuant to the judgment of a State court only on the ground that he is in custody in violation of the Constitution or laws or treaties of the United States." 28 U.S.C.

1 cert. denied, 469 U.S. 838 (1984). Despite Petitioner's vague assertion of a mental
2 disability, the petition filed in pro se is well-presented and clearly states his claims. (See
3 Docket No. 1.) Furthermore, it does not appear that an evidentiary hearing is necessary at
4 this early stage of the proceedings, and there are no exceptional circumstances to warrant
5 appointment of counsel at this time. Accordingly, Petitioner's motion for appointment of
6 counsel is **DENIED** without prejudice to the Court's sua sponte reconsideration should the
7 Court later find an evidentiary hearing necessary following consideration of the merits of
8 Petitioner's claims.

10 CONCLUSION

11 For the foregoing reasons, the Court orders as follows:

12 1. The court order filed on April 22, 2019, (Docket No. 11), is hereby
13 **VACATED**. Petitioner's motion for leave to proceed IFP is **GRANTED**. (Docket No. 7.)
14 No fee is due at this time.

15 2. Petitioner's motion for appointment of counsel, (Docket No. 13), is
16 **DENIED** without prejudice.

17 3. The Clerk shall serve by mail a copy of this order and the petition and all
18 attachments thereto, on Respondent and Respondent's attorney, the Attorney General of
19 the State of California. The Clerk also shall serve a copy of this order on Petitioner.

20 4. Respondent shall file with the court and serve on Petitioner, within **sixty (60)**
21 **days** of the issuance of this order, an answer conforming in all respects to Rule 5 of the
22 Rules Governing Section 2254 Cases, showing cause why a writ of habeas corpus should
23 not be issued. Respondent shall file with the answer and serve on Petitioner a copy of all
24 portions of the state trial record that have been transcribed previously and that are relevant
25 to a determination of the issues presented by the petition.

26 If Petitioner wishes to respond to the answer, he shall do so by filing a traverse with
27 the Court and serving it on Respondent within **thirty (30) days** of his receipt of the
