On October 12, 2021, Petitioner Alfredo Camargo filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this non-capital criminal matter. On October 22, 2021, the State of Arizona filed a waiver of the right to respond. However, on November 2, 2021, this Court ordered Arizona to respond by December 2, 2021. Under this Court's Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Respondents respectfully request an extension of 30 days, to and including January 3, 2022, to file a Brief in Opposition. Undersigned counsel has contacted Molly Karlin, counsel of record for Petitioner Camargo, and she has indicated that she has no objection to the requested 30-day extension. The extension is necessary due to undersigned counsel's responsibilities in other (primarily capital) cases, including helping to prepare alternate counsel for oral argument before this Court in *Shinn v.
