A response in this death-penalty case is currently due November 26, 2021. Respondent respectfully requests a thirty-day extension of the present deadline, up to and including December 26, 2021. This is Respondent's first request for an extension in this case. The extension is not sought for an improper purpose, including harassment or unnecessary delay. Rather, the undersigned attorney requires additional time due to the demands of a capital caseload.
