Petitioner, Jevon Dion Jackson, by and through undersigned counsel, asks leave to file in this Court without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Petitioner has been granted leave to proceed without payment of costs in the following courts:

- In the Supreme Court of the State of Wisconsin, No. 2017AP712
- In the Court of Appeals of the State of Wisconsin, No. 2017AP712
- In the Circuit Court of the County Milwaukee, Wisconsin, No. 1995CF951873

In the Circuit Court and during his direct appeal, counsel was appointed pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 967.06 (“Determination of indigency; appointment of counsel; preparation of record”). His post-conviction proceedings were handled on a pro bono basis by Ms.

Askins as part of her responsibilities at the University of Wisconsin Law School, and Mr. Jackson was permitted to go forward without payment of costs in those proceedings.

Because counsel was appointed pursuant to section 967.06 and Mr. Jackson was able to proceed without payment of costs throughout his litigation, under Supreme Court Rule 39, no affidavit is needed.
