Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel of record for a group of respondents in the above-captioned case: Goodwin Hospice, LLC; Phoenix Hospice, Inc.; International Tutoring Services, LLC; Curo Health Services, LLC; and Hospice Plus, LP. This case is currently pending before the Court on a petition for a writ of certiorari, which was filed on October 13, 2021 and placed on the docket on October 29, 2021. The response to the petition, after one extension, is currently due on February 18, 2022.

In accordance with this Court's Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an additional 14-day extension of time for all respondents to file a response, to and including March 4, 2022. The other respondents join in this request. This modest extension will not delay the ultimate timing of the case's disposition, and it is necessary due to the heavy press of other matters. It will also permit necessary coordination between respondents' counsel in this case and a related case, *Marchand & Rossi LLP v. Bryan K. White*, No. 21-796, which arise out of the same judgment. The Court requested a response to that petition on January 19 (currently due February 18), and it is likely that respondents will file a single response to both petitions. Finally, petitioner in this case submitted a supplemental brief on January 31, and this extension will further permit respondents to address the new arguments in that filing. Counsel for petitioner does not oppose this requested extension. I appreciate your attention to this matter.
