MOTION TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

CAPITAL CASE

Pursuant to Rule 39 of the Rules of this Court, Petitioner RICHARD BARRY RANDOLPH respectfully moves this Court for leave to file his accompanying Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Supreme Court of Florida without prepayment of fees and costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
