The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on November 24, 2021. Although the government waived its right to file a response, the Court has requested that a response be filed. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on February 18, 2022. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including March 17, 2022, within which to file a response.

This extension is necessary because the attorneys with principal responsibility for preparation of the government's response have been heavily engaged with the press of previously assigned matters with proximate due dates.
