Since October 9, 2019 Schneider continues to be involuntarily HOMELESS, locked out of his home, no way to make copies / forced to use 30+ year old "carbon" paper (and binder paper) for "copies" to serve with all his home's possessions stolen by Respondents without any due process e.g. All his legal files/supplies/law books/work product/notes, clothes, food, computers, scanners, printers, copiers, KEYS, MONEY, Passport etc.; See Record-Complaint filed

Schneider therefore has lived for years/lives
a DAILY "life" in many ways more
restrictive than Millions of "U.S. Prisoners"
(e.g. Mr. Grimsley; 18-7713).

Under the U.S. Constitution's Equal
Protection/Due Process and First Amendment
I object to the U.S. Supreme Court's system
of classifying prose (IFP) NON Prisoners in
the "5000 Series" of case numbers. This
forces Petitioner-Schneider into systemic
unequal discrimination and classification
based solely upon his involuntary wealth

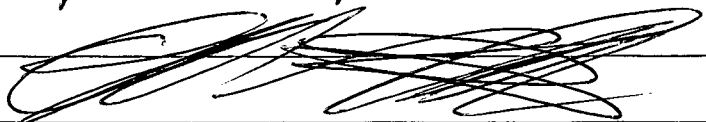

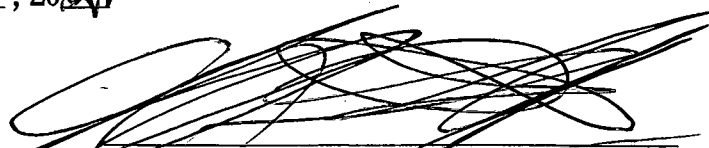
