BASED ON THE FILE, RECORD, AND PROCEEDINGS, AND BECAUSE:

1. On June 24, 2021, petitioner filed a petition for a writ of prohibition.
2. On July 13, 2021, this court issued an order directing appellant to remedy deficiencies in this matter by July 23, 2021. Specifically, this order instructed petitioner to (a) provide proof of service of his petition on the attorney general and state public defender, and (b) either pay the \$550 filing fee required for this petition or provide a copy of a district court order granting him leave to proceed in forma pauperis in this matter.
3. On July 21, 2021, petitioner provided proof of service of his petition on the state public defender and attorney general.
4. On August 4, 2021, petitioner filed a petition for accelerated review with the Minnesota Supreme Court.
