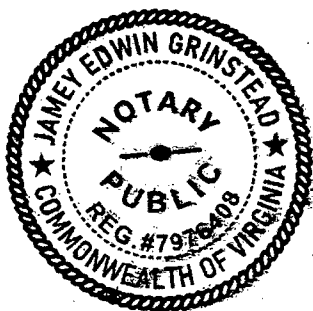
The record proves Facts (undisputed), Timothy Fisher violated The United States Constitution and acted contrary to controlling Federal laws.

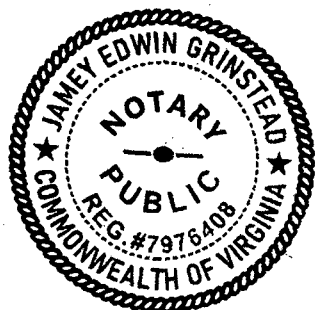

Those conditions and circumstances are subjecting me to cruel, inhuman and degrading treatment in violation of Human Rights Article Five (5). The unlawful attacks on my honor and reputation by the persons libel and slander violates the International Covenant on (civil) and (political) rights Articles Seven (7) and Article One (1). The petitioner has a right to the equal protection of laws that protect from verbal and physical attacks, which may be designed to deter my right to be self-determined and develop my economic, social and
