I, Benson, Ada Maria, Persona propria, (Per Se) hereby certify under the 28 U.S. Code § 1746 that this petition for rehearing is presented in good faith and not for delay, pursuant to the Supreme Court Rule 44.1, this petition for rehearing is filed within the 15 days requested by the Clerk of the Court in his letter attached of March 31, 2022.

I certify that the grounds of this petition are limited to substantial grounds not previously presented. Pages number 2 and 3 of the petition for Rehearing demonstrate new evidence of persecution as damages to the petitioner's health on March 30, 2022 after taking contaminated prescriptions that the petitioner picked up at Rite Aid pharmacy affecting further the health of the petitioner. Law enforcement were at the door of the pharmacy while the petitioner got the prescriptions. This should be considered an "'extraordinary intervening circumstance.'" App. to Pet. for Cert. 102 (quoting United States v. Simpson, 439 F. 3d 490, 496 (CA8 2006)). that were not presented in the original petition. Furthermore the persecution has continued and is evidenced in pages 2 and 3 of this petition.
