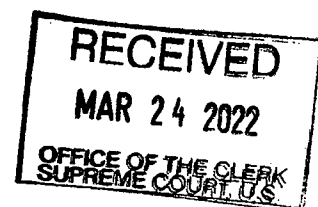

(1) now any petition filed under R.C. 2953.21 or application filed under App. R. 26(B) or any recast post-trial motion can be dismissed for a failure to file an affidavit or prior actions under R.C. 2969.25(A) because DeVore v. Black turned procedurs that are civil in nature into full-blown civil actions; and,


