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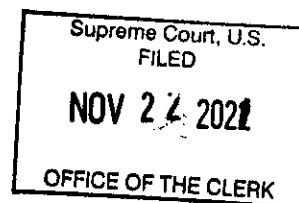

The Petitioner asks leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.


I have been granted leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in the Eighth Circuit Appellate Court.
