RELIEF SOUGHT

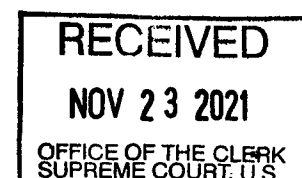


