O R D E R

Jason Michael Terrell seeks to appeal his sentence. The Government has moved to dismiss the appeal as barred by Terrell's waiver of the right to appeal included in the plea agreement. Upon review of the plea agreement and the transcript of the Fed. R. Crim. P. 11 hearing, we conclude that Terrell knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to appeal and that the claims Terrell seeks to raise on appeal fall squarely within the scope of his waiver of appellate rights. Accordingly, we grant the Government's motion to dismiss.
