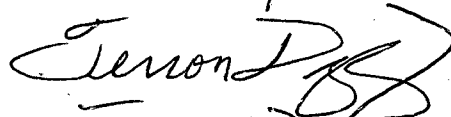
Petitioner is currently unlawfully imprisoned, and a pro-se litigant, and under such circumstances he is dealing with serious health
