TO THE HONORABLE CLERK OF THE
UNITED STATES SUPREME COURT:

COMES NOW Rashed Ali Muhammad, the
Petitioner, pro se, and respectfully moves this
Court pursuant to Rule 30 of the Supreme
Court of the United States, for an order
extending the time to file a Petition for
Writ of Certiorari To the Supreme Court;
from the current date of December 20, 2021,
for a period of sixty (60) days, to February
20, 2022, because of the following reasons:

1. The Petitioner has filed for a copy
of the fifth circuit court of appeals opinion
and still has not received a copy. The
Petitioner is currently waiting for the
opinion to arrive. See Exhibit "A".

2. The Petitioner has been in a facility
(USP FLORENCE) that has been locked down
since October of this year. There has been
3 murders within the past ninety (90) days.
The Petitioner has sent requests to the Case
Manager to get time to review his legal documents
and NO ONE has responded. Currently inmates
have NO access to the law library, emails,
telephone, OR case managers. Exhibit "B"

3. The delay in Petitioner receiving a copy
of the lower court's decision and being
"locked down" is beyond the Petitioner's control.
The Petitioner has filed a motion to recall the
mandate and amend judgment to avoid filing
this motion, Petitioner has not heard back from the
lower court. See Exhibit "C"

4. This motion is made in the interest of

justice and not meant to delay the proceedings.

Court to grant an order extending the time
by sixty (60) days to file a Petition for
Writ of Habeas Corpus (Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus).
