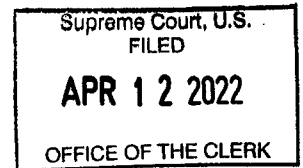

I acknowledge that the Brief in Opposition must be filed by a member of the Bar of the Supreme Court of the United States.

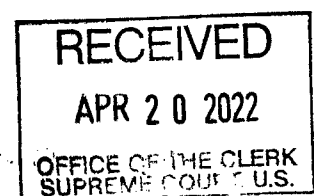
The Petition for Cert. was placed on the Docket on March 16, 2022. The due date for briefs in opposition is presently April 15, 2022.
