


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PETITION FOR A WRIT OF CERTIORARI

Pursuant to Rule 44,2

James Ray Davis respectfully petition
for rehearing of the Court May 23th
2022, order denying certiorari in
this case No. 21-7417.

GROUND FOR Rehearing

I James R. Davis draw the Court's
attention to the failures on the part
of either the district Court or the
Eight Circuit to remand the case
to allow for additional translation of
documents pertaining directly
to the central factual and legal issue, most notably
the decision of an ~~other~~ appellate court vacating
the convictions of the defendants in a companion
case to this one, and transcripts of the trial in that
Davis case. This substantial and significant ground was
raised in the courts below, but was not previously presented
in this Court due solely to space limitations in the Petition
for a Writ of Certiorari. Petitioners submit that this information
augments the previously filed Petition and highlights the need
to address the question of whether U.S. law enforcement should
be able to circumvent the Constitution by relying on a joint investiga-
tion involving foreign law enforcement; my right was violated

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Conclusion

Base on the grounds stated above, which were not previously presented to the Court, rehearing of the denial of a Petition for a ~~Supreme~~ Writ of Certiorari should be granted.

ORDER

The Eighth Circuit has dismissed James Ray Davis's appeal, assessed the full \$505 appellate filing and docketing fees against him, and remanded for collection. Doc. No. 103. Davis will be obligated to make monthly payments in the amount of twenty percent of the preceding month's income credited to his trust account each time the amount in the account exceeds \$10 until the fee has been paid in full. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(2).


